



Dear Valued Patients,

We wanted to give you an update regarding our response to COVID-19 pandemic. We are sure many of you have already been impacted in some way by the situation. This is a tough time.

We have been issued an executive order by the Oregon Governor to cease all non-emergency care in order to preserve PPE (masks, gloves, etc) for first responders until June 15, 2020.

In an effort to support natural efforts to fight the COVID-19 pandemic, our practice is taking the following steps to help assure your health and well-being and that of our community:

- Your health, and the health of our dedicated staff, matters to us, so going forward we will suspend all non-emergency care until June 15, 2020.
- Patients will be seen, in office, **only** for emergent dental needs, which include:
 - Severe pain or intense discomfort
 - Dental infection, swelling or abscess
 - Trauma with pain
 - Risk of rapidly worsening to severe symptoms (time sensitive)

If you are unsure if you are experiencing an emergency, Drs. Dahl & Coulombe will be available to return calls and evaluate if emergency treatment is indicated.

The safety and well-being of our patients and staff continues to be our primary concern. We will continue to monitor the status of COVID-19 nationally and within our community and keep you up-to-date regarding our plans to reopen for business as usual.
